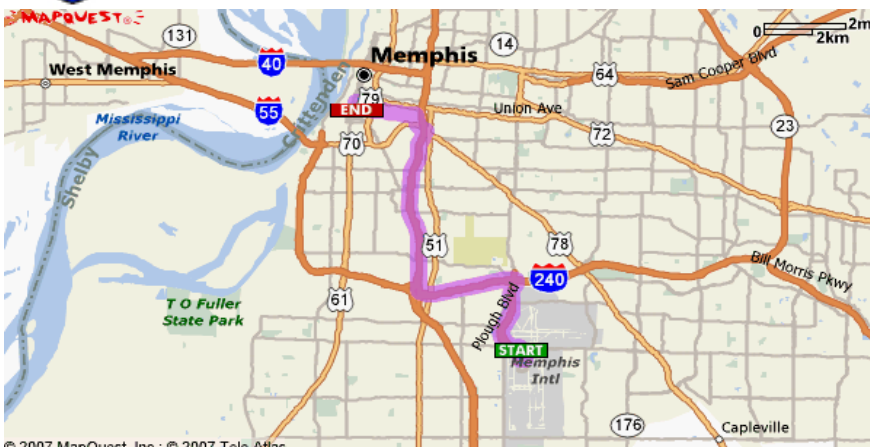

- START** Start out going SOUTH on WINCHESTER RD. <0.1 miles
-  Turn SLIGHT LEFT toward MEMPHIS INTL-PARKING LOT A/ CARGO. <0.1 miles
-  Turn SLIGHT LEFT. <0.1 miles
-  Turn SLIGHT LEFT, **AGAIN** <0.1 miles
-  Turn SHARP RIGHT onto WINCHESTER RD. <0.1 miles
-  Turn SHARP RIGHT, **AGAIN** <0.1 miles
- RAM** Take the ramp toward I-240. 0.5 miles
-  Merge onto FLOUGH BLVD. 1.3 miles
-  Merge onto I-240 W toward LITTLE ROCK / DOWNTOWN. 2.6 miles

-  Merge onto I-240 N. 3.9 miles
 -  Take the LAMAR AVE exit- EXIT 29. 0.1 miles
 -  Turn LEFT onto LAMAR AVE / US-78 / TN-4. 0.2 miles
 -  Turn RIGHT onto S SOMERVILLE ST / TN-278. Continue to follow TN-278. 0.2 miles

 -  Turn RIGHT onto S DANNY THOMAS BLVD / US-64 E / US-70 N / US-79 N / TN-1 N. 0.1 miles
 -  Turn LEFT onto BEALE ST. 0.3 miles
